For crafting, you will need:

Baking tray and baking paper, brush, scissors, transparent all-purpose glue, tweezers, pliers

For decorating, you will need:

• Rhinestones • Ribbon, pink & white checks • Necklace and bracelet in gold or leather cord in black • Snap hooks, gold finish, approx. 13 mm long • Eyelets, round, gold finish, ø 0.6 mm and ø 10 mm • Eyelet pins, gold finish, 18 mm long each • 2 earring hooks, gold finish, 20 mm long each

Instructions for trendy jewellery



Take a block of FIMO in the required colour and roll out to a flat sheet using the acrylic roller first and then the clay machine on setting 1. Place it on the baking paper.



Print and cut the pattern sheets out and position them on the sheet of FIMO. Then cut the motifs out of the sheet of FIMO soft by going around the edges of the templates with the kitchen knife.



To make gold stars, place gold leaf metal on a sheet of yellow FIMO soft, smooth over carefully with your finger and cut out a star.

To create a used look, roll the leaf metal together with the FIMO through the clay machine.

This creates small, effective-looking cracks in the leaf metal (crackle look).



Instructions for trendy jewellery



For attaching the jewellery later, push an eyelet pin sideways into one of the points of the star or moon. Now press the rhinestones into the star. Then, harden in the oven for approx. 30 minutes at 110°C, leave to cool and varnish.

Important! Use heat-resistant deco stones only (e.g. iron-on rhinestones).



To make a pair of hot lips, shape approx. two and a half portions of cherry red FIMO soft into a ball. Roll the ball with your hand to form a cylinder and shape the ends to a point using your fingers. Use the modeling stick to make an indent in the middle of the top lip and to draw a deep, horizontal line for separating the top from the bottom lip. Push an eyelet pin into the middle of the top lip and press a heat-resistant rhinestone in the upper lip for decoration too. Then harden for approx. 30 minutes at 110°C, leave to cool and varnish.



Attach the charms to the necklace and bracelet or thread onto a length of leather cord.

FINISHED! For a partner look, make the same necklace for you and your best friend!

TIP: Trendy on their own too – individual large, glamorously decorated stars or over-sized hot lips are great for attracting attention. Simply string onto a length of cotton or leather cord and you are left with a perfect necklace. If you wear several of these necklaces together at the same time, they look even more cool.
